

Legacy Youth Mentoring is looking for volunteers!!


How to become a mentor:

- 6) Meet with your student for 30 minutes at least two to four times a month.






Youth Kayaking Trip on the Broad River

Anticipation is in the air! Anticipation of going back to school, anticipation of the continuing expectations of the programs of this church. Your Trustees share this anticipation.

About 50 church members enthusiastically participated in a day of discussion groups with architects Barbara Black and Josh Koons. Many ideas to improve our present facilities as well as future needs were expressed. Barbara and Josh will prepare a written summary of the discussions for our review. Then they will prepare sketches of various design approaches to address short-term and long-term goals as determined by the discussions, eventually leading to Master Plans. Many thanks to those of you who participated.

The air conditioning unit in the Office Building has been replaced. Orkin has installed a gutter guard system on the Office Building that will prevent rodents from entering the attic and has treated the crawl space with borate to kill fungus and beetles. Trustees have installed new protective coverings on the gable vents to prevent bats from entering the attic.

Trustees are looking into options for camera systems to address security issues. We appreciate your input and participation as we anticipate only great things for our Church going forward. Thank you!
